

IMPROVEMENTS AND UPGRADES TO CASEMAKER 2.1!

Recently several exciting upgrades were incorporated into Casemaker. Enhanced CaseCheck and system-wide CaseKnowledge are now available.



- Users will no longer be limited to only the most recent 25 case within CaseCheck. Access to ALL cases that have cited a case being viewed are now available in an easy to navigate pop-up window. Having CaseCheck results appear in a pop-up window will also guarantee that you will never navigate away from the case that you are viewing.
- CaseCheck is now operational within the MultiBook Search in each individual state library, as well as, in the Federal Library. CaseCheck results will appear when the Case Law book is highlighted within MultiBook and a specific case is chosen for view.



- CaseKnowledge has been restructured within a state/federal Case Law search to list all publications by 'Current State', 'Third Party', and 'Additional Sources' (such as other state publications). In order to provide a faster user experience, the listing of the resources will be viewed in a pop-up window after a source is chosen. This will also provide the ability to never navigate away from the results page.

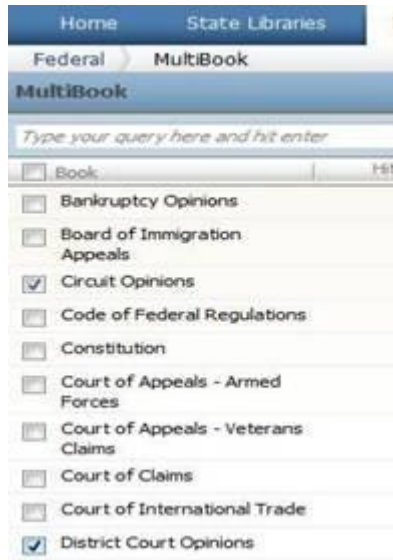
ADDITIONAL UPGRADES

- A larger and more prominent window will appear when a user clicks the "Sign Out" link in the top right corner of Casemaker.
- Checkboxes have been added to the MultiBook Search. Users may now either check all in order to run a search of ALL books within a particular state/federal library



–OR–

Users may select specific books within a particular state/federal library to search within. For example, a user may choose to search Circuit Courts & District Courts ONLY within the Federal Library.
