Topic: Case update on *Justice v. Vercher*.

A year after filing, what is the status of the case filed by Justice -- a neglected horse -- against his former owner.

Bio: Sarah Hanneken is an attorney based in Portland, Oregon, where she uses her law degree to protect the interests of animals and advance the animal liberation movement. Sarah uses her creativity and extensive advocacy experience to develop novel legal strategies designed to shift people's perception of the non-human species with whom we share our homes, neighborhoods, and planet.

Sarah currently works as Associate Counsel for the international farmed animal protection organization Animal Equality. Before that, Sarah worked for 4.5 years in the Litigation Program at the Animal Legal Defense Fund (ALDF), where she honed her skills as a litigator and activist. She continues to work on cases for ALDF on a pro bono basis, including the case of Justice the horse.
