PODCAST PROMPT

The 2021 Law Day theme is *Advancing the Rule of Law*. The “rule of law” is based on the ideal of a just society where laws are created consistent with principles of human rights and enforced equally for all to ensure that no person or entity is above the law.

For your podcast, explore the idea of how to promote the rule of law to better defend liberty and create a more just society. Start with a quote about the rule of law and use it to help explain the importance of the rule of law. Then discuss a specific example tied to your quote that illustrates how to advance the rule of law.
