- ★ Students may submit draft podcasts to ILF for review prior to finalizing their podcasts.
- ★ Podcasts must adhere to the Podcast Contest criteria, guidelines, and rubric found on our website.

PODCAST PROMPT

The 2022 Law Day theme is *Toward a More Perfect Union: The Constitution in Times of Change*.

The United States Constitution is a dynamic document that offers mechanisms for change that allow our country to continually strive to become a more perfect union. Since 1787, our Constitution has been amended 27 times.

For this year's podcast, let's explore change to our Constitution and how it moves our country forward. You can approach this theme in one of two ways:

1. Choose one of the 27 Constitutional amendments to explore and analyze; or
2. Create your own proposed Constitutional amendment.
