



Topics or Subject Areas for Idaho Bar Examination Questions

By order of the Idaho Supreme Court, Idaho adopted the Uniform Bar Examination (UBE). *See* Idaho Bar Commission Rule 217. The first UBE to be administered in Idaho will be in February 2012. Bar examination questions are limited to the following topics or subject areas of the law:

1. Federal Civil Procedure
2. Conflict of Laws
3. Constitutional Law
4. Contracts
5. Business Organizations (Agency & Partnership, Corporations and Limited Liability Companies)
6. Uniform Commercial Code (Articles II, III and IX)
7. Family Law
8. Criminal Law and Procedure
9. Evidence
10. Real Property
11. Torts
12. Estates and Trusts (Decedent's Estates and Trusts; Future Interests)

Bar examination questions on the above topics or subject areas must be of a general nature, not requiring specific knowledge of any variance of the Idaho law.
