The United States Judicial Panel on Multidistrict Litigation, known as the MDL Panel, is conducting a hearing session on various matters pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1407 on Thursday, July 29, 2010. In the matters designated for oral argument (see page two), counsel presenting oral argument must be present at 8:15 a.m. in order for the Panel to allocate the amount of time for oral argument. Oral argument will commence at 9:30 a.m.

The Courthouse will open at 6:30 a.m. that morning. Please be advised that seating is limited, as well as parking in and around the Courthouse. Each person arriving at the Courthouse will be screened, and therefore, please allow plenty of time to make your way to the courtrooms, which are located on the Sixth Floor.

The MDL Panel consists of seven sitting federal judges, who are appointed to serve on the Panel by the Chief Justice of the United States. The job of the Panel is to (1) determine whether civil actions pending in different federal districts involve one or more common questions of fact such that the actions should be transferred to one federal district for coordinated or consolidated pretrial proceedings; and (2) select the judge or judges and court assigned to conduct such proceedings.
