## Idaho Rule of Professional Conduct 6.1:

Every lawyer has a professional responsibility to provide legal services to those unable to pay. A lawyer should aspire to render at least (50) hours of pro bono legal services per year to persons of limited means or to charitable, religious, civic, community, governmental and educational organizations.



## What is the 6.1 Challenge?

The 6.1 Challenge is an event to encourage and formally recognize pro bono and public service activities from members of the Fourth District Bar through office team participation.

## What does our office team get if we are recognized?

The 2011 6.1 Challenge Award for Pro Bono for each category of law office will be presented at a reception on April 29, 2011. The offices recognized will receive a plaque immortalizing their teams' achievement placed in the Ada County Courthouse.



## What does an office team need to do to participate?

Forms must be received no later than 5 P.M. on Friday, April 8, 2011.

## Who is reviewing the submissions?

Submissions will be reviewed by a distinguished panel, including members of the federal and state judiciary and local community leaders.

The panel will evaluate the type and quality of the pro bono activities and the percentage of attorneys participating, as well as the number of hours conducted on behalf of the community, to determine which office teams will be recognized for each category of law office. The categories include: small, large and government law offices.
