LOW INCOME TAXPAYER CLINIC

WHO WE SERVE

The Tax Clinic provides qualified low-income taxpayers with free legal representation in federal tax controversies.

Clients are represented by College of Law student interns who are trained and directly supervised by an experienced tax attorney.

The Tax Clinic is not part of the IRS. All telephone conversations and in-person conferences are treated with the utmost confidentiality.

Eligibility for our service is based on income and family size. To qualify for free representation your income must fall within the following guidelines.

Add \$10,050 for each additional member.

TAX ISSUES WE HANDLE

The University of Idaho College of Law Tax Clinic is a comprehensive federal tax controversy clinic.

- We represent taxpayers during the audit process.
- We represent taxpayers in connection with administrative appeals of adverse audit or collection function determinations.
- We represent taxpayers who receive notices from the Internal Revenue Service collection division concerning delinquent tax liabilities, and we assist taxpayers with securing installment agreements, offers in compromise, or other alternatives to full and immediate payment of the tax debt, as circumstances warrant.
- We assist taxpayers who have received a notice of levy or notice of filing federal tax lien.
- We represent taxpayers who have trials before the United States Tax Court.
- We do not provide tax preparation services.

TO FIND OUT MORE

To find out whether the Tax Clinic can represent you, call the Clinic at 208.364.6166. An intake specialist will return your call. She will take information from you to determine your eligibility for tax clinic services and the nature of your tax problem. You will be asked to provide the tax clinic with the IRS letters and notices that prompted your call to the tax clinic.

The intake specialist will then meet with the supervising tax clinic attorney to determine whether we can represent you. Some of the factors that will be considered are the nature and urgency of your problem and the amount of time the student or other tax clinic students will need to work on your problem. You will be informed after the initial meeting whether the clinic will represent you.
