| All requests to transfer to active status: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit written request, • Comply with the Active licensing requirements, and • Certify completion of 30 credits (including 2 ethics credits) in past three years or complete 10 credits within 60 days of transfer to active. • <i>Transfer from inactive to active status also requires payment of all unpaid past dues at the rate of an affiliate member plus applicable late fees.</i> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Submit written request, • Comply with the Active licensing requirements, • Submit certificates of good standing and discipline reports from all states where licensed, • Submit discipline report from Idaho State Bar, and • Certify not convicted of felony or serious crime. • <i>Transfer from resigned to active status under IBCR 301(I)(2) also requires payment of \$150 and is only available until 3/1/13.</i> |
| 1 – 3 Years since Active in Idaho: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State not convicted of felony or serious crime. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Complete 10 credits within 60 days of transfer to active. |
| 3 – 5 Years since Active in Idaho: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 1-3 years, and • Provide proof attorney is competent to practice law in Idaho. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certify completion of 30 credits (including 2 ethics credits) in past three years or within 90 days of transfer to active. |
| 5 – 7 Years since Active in Idaho: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 3-5 years. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 3-5 years, • Successfully complete a character and fitness examination under IBCR 208-210, and • Provide proof attorney has practiced law in another jurisdiction for 3 of the past 5 years or proof attorney is competent to practice law in Idaho. |
| 7 – 10 Years since Active in Idaho: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 3-5 years. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 5-7 years, and • An attorney who has not practiced law in another jurisdiction for past 7 years or longer may be required to take and pass all or a portion of the bar exam. |
| More than 10 Years since Active in Idaho: | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 3-5 years. | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Meet requirements of 7-10 years, except • An attorney who has not practiced law in another jurisdiction for past 10 years or longer must apply for admission under IBCR Section II. |
