


### Climate Change State Actions

  - Develop further recommendations


## GHG Emission Sources Cabinet-level State Agencies




# Department of Environmental Quality GHG Emission Sources



- Developing Carbon Sequestration Plan
- Fuel efficiency purchase standards for state fleet (E.O. 2007-21)
