


Family Law Section meeting minutes

June 10, 2016

1. Meeting called to order by Vice Chair, Jen Brumley.

3. Review of May meeting minutes and financials were deferred until the next regular business meeting in August.
 - a. **Seat 1: National family law conferences** Jennifer Schindele recently attended the conference in Seattle, WA. She will be putting together a brief CLE to present soon.
