A. Access to Justice Campaign – request for section support (Kelli Ketlinski)

In 2014 Access to Justice Idaho began its campaign to raise funds to provide support for the three principal providers of free legal services for poor and vulnerable Idahoans. These organizations are the Idaho Volunteer Lawyers Program, Idaho Legal Aid Services, and Disability Rights Idaho.

Disability Rights Idaho's mission is to assist people with disabilities, to protect, promote and advance their rights through quality advocacy and representation. Idaho Legal Aid Services is a statewide nonprofit law firm dedicated to providing equal access to justice for low income people through advocacy and education. Idaho Volunteer Lawyers program works to secure private pro-bono attorneys for vulnerable Idahoans and coordinates legal clinics to assist people throughout the state.

Access to Justice asks the Government and Public Law Section to consider joining the many practice sections who are donating to the campaign. A contribution to Access to Justice Idaho will ensure these Idaho organizations continue to serve the poor and those with disabilities throughout Idaho in cases such as domestic violence, foreclosure prevention, disability claims, access to long-term care, guardianships, and other legal services that would otherwise be out of reach.
