Idaho Mock Trial Director Named to National Board

BOISE – Carey Shoufler, the Idaho Law Foundation’s Law Related Education Director, has been named to Board of Directors for the National High School Mock Trial Championship. Each year the national competition hosts about 50 teams from U.S. states and territories. Ms. Shoufler has organized Idaho’s Mock Trial competition for eight years, directing regional and state competition and preparing case materials for mock trial teams around Idaho.

Through participation in the Idaho High School Mock Trial Competition, high school students are given a hands-on opportunity to examine the legal process and current legal issues while they develop important critical thinking, research, and presentation skills. In mock trial high school students learn how to try cases in court, arguing facts and law, calling witnesses, cross examination and submitting evidence to the judge.
