Meeting Minutes September 22, 2021

- 1. <u>Introduction & Welcome</u>. Talasi Brooks welcomed everyone and notified Section members that monthly Section meetings will be virtual for the foreseeable future.
- 2. <u>May Meeting Minutes.</u> Section members in attendance voted to approve the draft May 2021 meeting minutes.
- 3. <u>Treasurer's Report.</u> Bryan Hurlbut reported on the section's financials through July 2021, and discussed potential ways to spend down surplus funds, including paying CLE speakers, contributing to other environmental and/or legal causes connected to the ISB, and other options. Marie Kellner indicated she will submit a proposal to the Section for contributing to the Idaho Environmental Forum, and Talasi Brooks will contact the ISB to seek a proposal related to their assistance with the Section.
- 4. The Year Ahead. Talasi Brooks discussed the plan to continue holding monthly Section meetings and host a CLE in January, as in years past. Talasi and the Section discussed sponsoring another issue of *The Advocate*, likely a year or more from now. Talasi noted additional opportunities, including setting up a listserve for Section members.
- 5. <u>Announcements.</u> Marie Kellner announced that Public Lands Day is Saturday, September 25, with opportunities to get involved.
- 6. <u>CLE.</u> Talasi Brooks, Staff Attorney at Western Watersheds Project, gave a 35-minute CLE presentation titled "Judicial deference to administrative agencies' interpretation of their own regulations post-*Kisor*."
