Order Granting Petition for Interim Suspension of License to Practice Law

A PETITION FOR INTERIM SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW, an AFFIDAVIT OF CARALEE A. LAMBERT IN SUPPORT OF PETITION FOR INTERIM SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW, (3) DECLARATIONS, and a MOTION TO SEAL RECORDS were filed by Petitioner on November 30, 2023, requesting an Order immediately suspending Respondent's license to practice law in Idaho, and sealing the three declarations filed on November 30, 2023, pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32(i)(2)(A).

The Court being fully advised and after review of this matter, it clearly appears that from the specific facts reflected in the Petition, Affidavit and Declarations that Respondent R. Aaron Morriss poses a substantial threat of irreparable harm to the public. Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that the PETITION FOR INTERIM SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW of Respondent R. Aaron Morriss is GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Respondent R. Aaron Morriss, is IMMEDIATELY PLACED UPON A PERIOD OF INTERIM SUSPENSION OF LICENSE TO PRACTICE LAW in the State of Idaho. Further, Respondent R. Aaron Morriss shall comply specifically with Disciplinary Rules 516 and 517 and this period of interim suspension shall remain in effect until further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the MOTION TO SEAL RECORDS is GRANTED, and the three declarations filed with this Court on November 30, 2023, are SEALED pursuant to I.C.A.R. 32(i)(2)(A).


