Hello Melanie,

We are writing to seek a sponsorship from the Family Law Section for Hilarity for Charity, the annual fundraising event by Attorneys for Civic Education (ACE). ACE is a community service project of the Government & Public Sector Lawyers Section. **We are in need of a Section Sponsor/Partner to cover the approximately \$1000 cost of producing the event, but we welcome with great gratitude any contribution. More now than ever, our Idaho students need the programs that we assist in funding!**

ACE is an organization of volunteers who work to increase support – whether in the form of attorney volunteers or direct monetary support – for three civic education programs in Idaho: We the People, Idaho High School Mock Trial, and YMCA Youth in Government. Each of these organizations seeks to educate students in grades 9-12 about the law, our legal system, and our government, largely through hands-on experiences.

We the People students serve as witnesses in simulated Congressional hearings dealing with public policy, including significant Constitutional issues, and compete in regional, state, and national competitions. Idaho Mock Trial students participate in a simulated trial, and compete in regional, state, and national competitions. Youth in Government students run for and elect state officials in anticipation of their April conference, where they lobby, defend, and pass bills through the House and Senate; and make oral arguments to the student judges of the “Idaho Supreme Court.”

Hilarity for Charity is ACE’s signature fund-raising event, now in its sixth year. Hilarity for Charity is a night of improvisational comedy. A professional troupe performs improvisational skits based on audience suggestions, and members of the audience also volunteer to get on stage and channel their inner Improv comic.
