The Court, having received a recommendation to amend the Infraction Penalty Schedule found in Idaho Infraction Rule 9(b) to comport with new legislation, and the Court being fully informed:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Idaho Infraction Rule 9(b) be amended as follows:

Rule 9. Judgment – Fixed penalty plus court costs for infractions – Withheld judgment and suspended penalties prohibited – Deferred payment agreements.

(b) **Fixed Penalty and Costs for Infraction.** The entry of a judgment for an infraction under this rule shall order the defendant to pay a dollar amount for a fixed penalty and court costs in the following amounts:

32 Fish and Game: violations of I.C. § 36-1401(a)(1)(K)-(L) & (a)(2)(<u>SU</u>)-(<u>XY</u>)

I.C. § 36-1401

\$250.00

Total Fine (fixed penalty + court costs) \$314.00

The lining through and underlining shall not be considered a part of the permanent Idaho Infraction Rules.
