ORDER

The Court, having received recommendations to amend Idaho Infraction Rules 9(b) and 10, and being fully informed:

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED the Idaho Infraction Rules be amended as follows:

Rule 9. Judgment – Fixed penalty plus court costs for infractions – Withheld judgment and suspended penalties prohibited – Deferred payment agreements.

(b) **Fixed Penalty and Costs for Infraction.** The entry of a judgment for an infraction under this rule shall order the defendant to pay a dollar amount for a fixed penalty and court costs in the following amounts:

Rule 10. Failure to Pay Infraction – Late Payment – Other Sanctions.

(a) **Late Payment.** Late payment of an infraction shall be accepted by the court or clerk of the court at any time.

(b) **Other Sanctions.** Nothing in this rule shall limit the inherent powers of the court to enforce its judgments and orders by execution or by other means and sanctions authorized by law.

~~(c) **Cancellation.** If the penalty is not paid within a three (3) year period, the clerk shall then cancel the delinquent penalty and close the file.~~


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this order and these amendments shall be effective
July 1, 2022.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the above designation of the striking of words from the Rules by lining through them, and the designation of the addition of new portions of the Rules by underlining such new portion is for the purposes of information only as amended, and NO OTHER AMENDMENTS ARE INTENDED. The lining through and underlining shall not be considered a part of the permanent Idaho Infraction Rules.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that the Clerk of the Court shall cause notice of this Order to be published in one issue of *The Advocate*.


