

## **Notice: Changes to Idaho Court Email Addresses**

The Idaho Supreme Court is establishing new email addresses for individuals across the state who handle court work. This includes judges, clerks, court reporters, administrators and similar roles.

Courts in a few counties have already been moved to the new address system. Courts across the bulk of Idaho will be transitioned starting as soon as this Monday and possibly as late as this coming January.

Most state court employees (for example: judges, court reporters and trial court administrators) will have new email addresses that end in @idcourts.gov. Most county court clerks will have new email addresses that end in @countyname.idcourts.gov.

For both situations, email address formats will generally follow first initial, last name (for example: jdoe@bonneville.idcourts.gov).

Counties that moved to the new email format earlier may still have @idcourts.net addresses, as will accounts used by the Idaho Supreme Court and the Administrative Office of the Courts.

After a court moves to the new address format, you should receive an autoreply from their old account noting the transition. Please start using the new email address at that time for all email correspondence with that court.
