- Written protocol for investigation of CA
- Interviews of victims
- Investigations of family members with disability
- Role of each agency
- Procedures to access risk to child
- Procedures to be followed to ensure child's safety including removal of ^

Each team member shall be trained in his/her role, including risk assessment –
on the dynamics of child sexual abuse and interviewing and investigatory techniques.

Limited/Narrow Statutes

Lewd Conduct with a Minor under 16

- Specific Intent Crime:
 - Defendant must commit the act with the intent to gratify or arouse the sexual desire of self, child or third person
 - Typically, sex consist of genital touching vs. Sexual Abuse of a Child which is touching "not amounting to lewd conduct" and offender is over 18 yoa.

Statutes:

Sexual Abuse of a Minor Under 16: Specific Intent Crime Sexual Conduct is something less than Lewd Conduct

<u>Sexual Battery – Misdemeanor</u> Touching is without Specific Intent i.e.: Greenbelt; Groping in Bar

SEXUAL BATTERY OF A 16/17 YEAR OLD

^ is more than 5 years older;
Sexual Acts are either L/L (life), or
Sexual acts are Sexual Abuse (25 years)



What is the age of Consent in Idaho?

Answer: It depends. Under 16 regardless of age of ^. If 16 or 17, the offender must be at

least 3 years older than victim

Question: But what about Sex Battery?

There is no separate offense for "Stat Rape"

If the offender is 18 years of age and the victim is within 3 years, defendant would not have to register as a sex offender.

Consent to Marry

What is our obligation when we find out that a parent "consents" on behalf of their 15 year old daughter to marry a 30 year old man? 45? 60?

Consent to Marry

Court must give permission under 16 yoa

How do we get standing court to object?

Consent to Marry

If the child is 16 or 17 years of age, only the parent must consent.

What if the spouse is 30; 45; 60???

What is the MDT Responsibility?

Most of these cases are not Romeo/Juliet

Grooming Behavior

- 1. Engagement Phase: relationship; vulnerabilities;
- 2. Breaking Boundary Barriers: trust/access;
- 3. Inducements: positive/negative
- 4. Threats/Coercion to Continue
- 5. Touching becomes much more invasive: controlling the "relationship"
- 6. <u>Delayed Disclosure:</u> fear, guilt, shame, loss of relationship, not believed, fearing of hurting mom/siblings

Delayed Disclosure

Very rare that a child immediately discloses
No statute of limitations for L & L; Rape
(big gap for SA of Child/ Sex Battery of 16/17)

Rely on Expert Witnesses - - counselors, forensic interviewers to explain Delayed Disclosure and the Grooming process
