

**Minutes of the Meeting of the
Health Law Section of the
Idaho State Bar
February 4, 2021**

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Health Law Section of the Idaho State Bar was called to order by Immediate Past Section Chair Wendy Olson, on behalf of Section Chair Keely Duke, at 12:00 p.m. via Zoom video/teleconference on Thursday, February 4, 2021.

General Business:

Ms. Olson addressed the following matters of Section business:

- Minutes: a motion was made, and seconded, to approve minutes from the Section's previous meeting on December 3, 2020. With no objections, the motion to approve previous meeting minutes was affirmed.
- Financial Report and Calendar Year 2021 Budget Review: Secretary/Treasurer Brent Wilson reported on the Section's 2020 finances based on the Idaho State Bar's projections in the 2021 Health Law Section budget worksheet and the calendar year 2021 budget. Ms. Olson encouraged Section members to invite health care law practitioners who are not yet Section members to join, particularly because dues revenue are the primary source of funding for the Section and because the Section offers multiple benefits for membership in the form of quality CLE's.
- 2021 Meeting Schedule and CLE: Ms. Olson asked for suggestions for speakers and topics for future 2021 meetings. Brent Wilson suggested the new Information Blocking regulations and Scott Randolph suggested recent changes to the Stark and Anti-Kickback Statute as potential CLE topics. Ms. Olson encouraged Section members to suggest other topics and speakers via email.

CLE:

Tom Mortell, Partner in Hawley Troxell's Boise office, presented on the Idaho Patient Act and how this new law impacts how medical providers may collect for unpaid medical services in Idaho.
