

IDAHO ACADEMY OF LEADERSHIP FOR LAWYERS 2022 - 2023



You can be who you are and still be a leader.

The **Idaho Academy of Leadership for Lawyers (IALL)** is an interactive leadership training program designed specifically for lawyers. IALL is composed of an initial two-day session followed by four one-day sessions and a graduation. Classes will consist of a diverse group of 12-16 members of the Idaho State Bar. Each participant commits to the five scheduled IALL sessions. Qualified applicants will have been admitted to practice law for at least five years or practiced law and have five years professional experience.



TUITION FOR PARTICIPATION

The tuition for participating in IALL is \$800, payable in four equal installments by December 31, 2022. The tuition defrays costs associated with programming, course materials and group meals. Note this tuition only covers a portion of the overall costs. IALL will provide a travel stipend to participants from the 1st, 2nd, 5th, 6th, and 7th Districts to assist with travel expenses, as its budget allows. CLE credits may be available for certain programs.

Deadline for application

Submit your completed **IALL application, a cover letter providing information about yourself and two (2) reference letters in PDF format** to: Teresa Baker (tbaker@isb.idaho.gov) by 5:00 p.m. (MDT) by Monday, August 22, 2022 at 9:00 am. Applicants will be notified on September 6, 2022, as to whether they have been accepted into the 2022-2023 class.

SCHOLARSHIP ASSISTANCE

Scholarships are available. Do not let the cost of the program dissuade you from applying. A candidate in need of assistance should indicate so by attaching an addendum to the application explaining the basis for the request. If a candidate seeking scholarship assistance is selected for the class, members of the IALL Steering Committee will confidentially review the request, and will notify the candidate if assistance is available. Special thanks to the various organizations who have provided the financial support necessary to continue IALL scholarship assistance.

Service project

IALL participants will be asked to develop, implement, and evaluate a service project to benefit their local legal community and/or their community as a whole.

MISSION

IALL will bring together lawyers from different practice areas with a variety of backgrounds from all across Idaho. - Promoting professional obligations and community service; and

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

- **Submit** your completed application, cover letter and two (2) reference letters by 5:00 p.m. (MDT) on August 19, 2022.
- Be a member of the Idaho State Bar, in good standing.
- Have been admitted to the practice of law in a in a U.S. jurisdiction for a minimum of five (5) years or have at least five (5) years professional work experience with at least two of those years practicing law. Eligibility dates based on original Date of Admission
- **Participants** are expected to carry out a service project in their community.
- <u>100% attendance and participation is required for all sessions.</u>
