- c. The Governing Council also presents a funding request to sponsor a reception at the upcoming CARTF Conference in Boise, June 12-13, 2023, with a "do-pass" recommendation. The funding request is for up to \$700. With no questions or discussion, the expenditure was approved unanimously.

- d. Idaho Children at Risk Task Force is hosting a training conference on June 12-13 at the Riverside in Boise. The conference is free to attend and there are a few slots still available. The topic is "Inside the Courtroom from Removal to Resolution." There are plenary and breakout sections.

- CLE Deputy Attorney General Jessica Partridge, Carissa Decker, and Andie Blackwood from the Idaho Department of Health and Welfare presented a CLE titled "ICPC Update: Where are we Now?" CLE .5 pending.
