Talasi Brooks is a Staff Attorney with Western Watersheds Project, a nonprofit organization whose mission is to protect and restore western watersheds and wildlife through education, public policy initiatives, and legal advocacy. Her practice focuses on enforcing federal public land and wildlife management laws, as well as the Freedom of Information Act, to promote transparent federal land management that protects native biodiversity, ecosystems, and wild places.

She presently serves as the Section Chair for the Environment and Natural Resources Section of the Idaho State Bar.
