

**Minutes of the Meeting of the
Health Law Section of the
Idaho State Bar
April 1, 2021**

Call to Order:

A meeting of the Health Law Section of the Idaho State Bar was called to order by Chair Keely Duke, at 12:00 p.m. via Zoom video/teleconference on Thursday, April 1, 2021.

 - Rafael Gonzales, Acting United States Attorney District of Idaho on prosecutions and investigations into the distribution of illegal narcotics such as fentanyl, opioids, and counterfeit opioids and impact in Idaho – Darci Crane will reach out to Mr. Gonzales.
 - Idaho Attorney General settlement with opioid manufactures and distribution and use of settlement funds – Judy Geier will reach out to the AG's office
 - Litigation Update – this may be a topic for the October CLE.
