- A. Rule 8.4(g) discussion/presentation-
Previously we worked from the ABA model rule and a local committee prepared a draft. It was approved at the Roadshows but failed at the Idaho Supreme Court. An idea was introduced to re-characterize the rule and place it in the Standard for Civility in Professional Conduct. A discussion was held on whether adding it to the Standard for Civility in Professional Conduct goes far enough versus whether the Idaho Supreme Court would be amenable to a narrower rule to comport with the recent U.S.

Supreme Court cases and/or providing the Board with a background memo to resurrect the proposed rule. A working group may be formed to evaluate those options.
