- Rule 1.5: Fees
 - o Recommended reviewing your service agreements;
 - o Check billing guidelines with your firm;
 - o Go through the time with the partners at your firm to correctly track time you are billing to clients
 - o Examples of violations:
 - Inflating billing entries billing for work not performed.
 - Billing non-lawyer services at lawyer rates such as organizing a file, filing court documents.
 - Charging excessive fees for little work.
- Idaho state bar ethics division must have clear and convincing evidence of a rule violation to sanction lawyer this is a higher burden than preponderance of evidence.
 - o Must have very good evidence of rule violation he said/she said situations aren't likely to meet this.
- Accurately describe your work.
- Can always reach out to bar counsel for advice.
