August 12, 2016

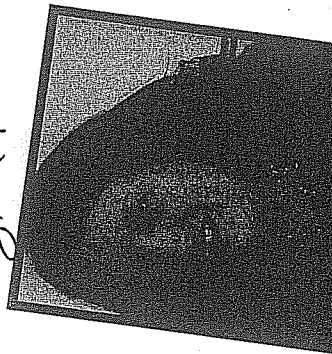
- Meeting called to order by Chair, Lisa Rodriguez.

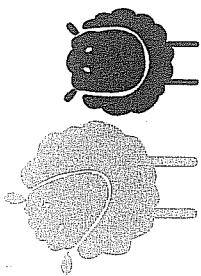
